Bids shall be received for the aforementioned items.

A certified check or bank draft on a responsible, solvent bank, or a satisfactory bid bond executed by the bidder and an acceptable surety company, payable to the Hannibal Board of Public Works, Darrin Gordon, or Government Bonds or cash in the amount of not less than five percent (5%) of bid, shall be submitted with each bid.

The bid shall be marked to identify bid package contents, reference specification 2156 K003.

The successful bidder will be required to:

- Register as a bidder for this project.
- Furnish **in duplicate** the following executed documents:
 - Non-Collusion Affidavit
 - Bid Form
 - Bid Bond, Certified Check or Money Order
 - And any other documents as required by the specifications.

No bid shall be withdrawn after the opening of bids without the consent of the Board for a period of sixty (60) days after the scheduled time of closing bids.

The said Hannibal Board of Public Works reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informalities in bidding, and to determine and accept the bid most advantageous to the Utility.
